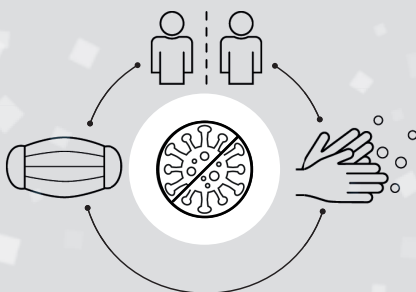

## ICCCX – Concrete Safety

Health and safety are top priorities for the ICCX organisers, especially in view of the challenges of COVID 19.

Below you will find a list of the protective measures that we will be observing at the ICCX event in Bonn 2 - 4 November 2021.

The ICCX will be held on the basis of the Corona Protection Ordinance in force on the day of the event. As of now, this means that the event will be open to **3G** status, that is recovered, vaccinated, tested, professionally conducted and documented antigen test max. 48h old persons. For the general hotel area, we will adopt the hygiene concept of Hotel Maritim Bonn which you can find at [www.maritim.de](http://www.maritim.de).

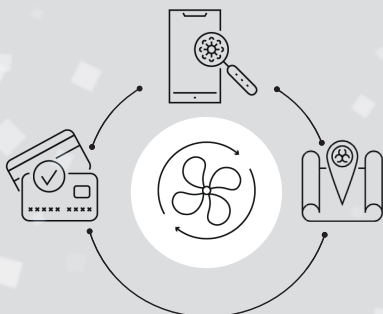

## Organisation

- Please register online to facilitate contactless registration processing on site and so that the traceability of all participants can be guaranteed based on the address data.
- Separate entrances and exits in the registration area
- Floor markings and, if necessary, the use of people guidance systems to minimise intersections and undesirable gatherings of visitors.
- All passage doors to remain permanently open with the exception of fire doors

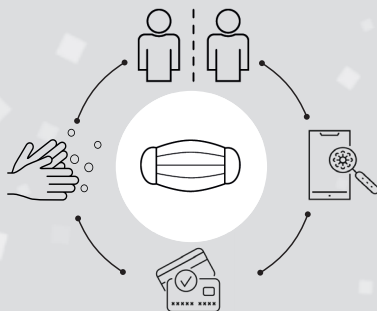

- There will be a QR code for the evening event and your 3G status will again be checked. Please bring your trade fair badge to the evening event.
- Notices will be displayed in both German and English.

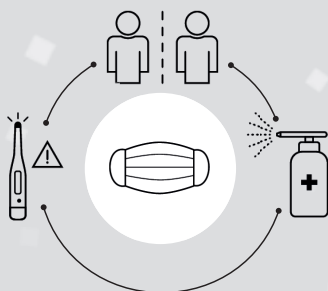

## Hygiene und health

- The event will be 3G (tested, recovered, vaccinated.) Proof must be presented upon receipt of the congress pass prior to entry.
- Sufficient number of disinfection dispensers throughout the exhibition area.
- Compliance with the mask regulations in situations such as queues at drinks counters and buffets. Signs will be posted in these cases, as the distance of 1.5m cannot always be guaranteed.
- Regular cleaning of surfaces that are touched frequently (handrails, tables, registration counters, etc.)
- Extra increased frequency of cleaning and disinfection of sanitary facilities
- Ample and regular air exchange in the exhibition and conference rooms
- Air conditioning with 100% fresh air

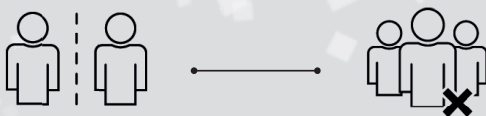

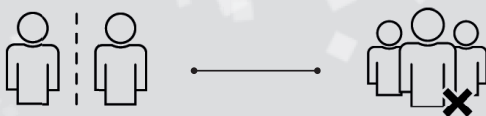
## Distance

- If necessary, a mask (FFP2, OP mask) must be worn on walkways when a distance of 1.5m cannot be maintained. Please pay attention to the signs.
- Floor markings as required to maintain minimum distances at registration, cloakroom etc.
- Masks are only obligatory on the way to and from the seats in the conference hall and on stage for exhibitor presentations. Masks may be taken off when seated.
